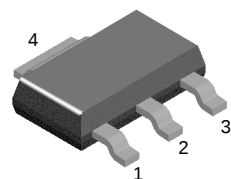


BCP51

PNP General Purpose Amplifier

- This device is designed for general purpose medium power amplifiers and switches requiring collector currents to 1.0A.
- Sourced from process 77.

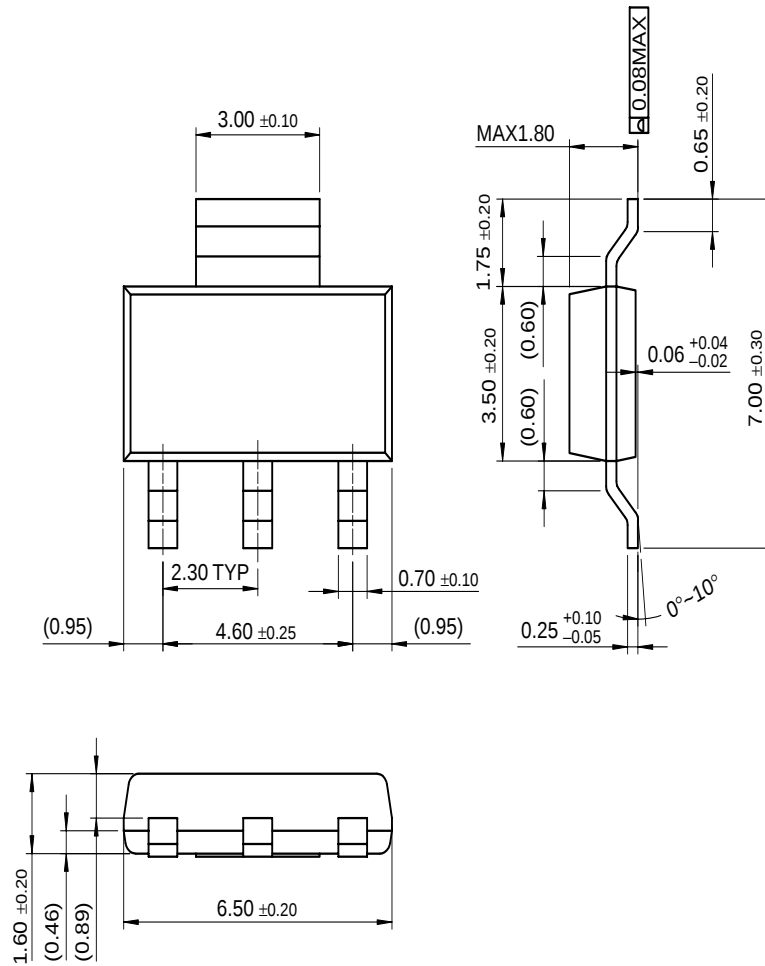
